This gives it an aspect ratio of 1:1.468 rather than the 1:root 2 aspect ratio of the ISO series paper sizes. In actuality the A3+ /Super A3 name is quite misleading as this paper size is known as B+ or Super B in the United States and is ANSI B with a 1" margin for print bleed.

However, if you're here and actually reading this description, you must either like oddball kind of things or really be in the need for a very specific size of paper. 13 x 19 paper is roughly equivalent to European Super A3 or +A3 paper, which many printers and Photoshop pros swear by for its full bleed capabilities.
