The 8th grade English Language Arts scores for 70 students were compared with their scores on the Spanish 1 Final Exam to determine if this state wide assessment test would serve as an accurate predictor of success in foreign language study. Research has shown that students' native language ability can be a predictor of how well they will do in their study of a foreign language. Pearson r correlation analysis was done comparing the Spanish 1 Final Exam scores with the 8th grade ELA total scores, as well as with each of the subgroup scores for the three ELA standards. However, the results of this study show more of a tendency than a correlation. This may be due to a number of factors. Previous researchers used a combination of aptitude and achievement tests while this researcher was able to use only achievement tests. Because the seventy participants were students of four different Spanish 1 teachers, this variable could have had an impact on the results. Further recommendations are made for school districts to consider as a means of increasing student achievement in foreign language study.

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
