Teamwork can only be possible through a shared vision, empowerment with stake in decision making, transparency in information, etc. Collective bargaining, conciliation (inducing a friendly feeling), negotiation, mediation (when negotiation fails), and arbitration are the most useful examples of conflict resolution in organizations.

Conflict resolution is conceptualized as the methods and processes involved in facilitating the peaceful ending of conflict and retribution. Committed group members attempt to resolve group conflicts by actively communicating information about their conflicting motives or ideologies to the rest of group (e.g., intentions; reasons for holding certain beliefs) and by engaging in collective ...
