These projections were revised upward in the late summer and fall of 1929, when first Gosplan (the state planning commission) called for the collectivization of 2.5 million peasant households in the course of 1929-1930, and then Kolkhozsentr (the central agency at the head of collective-farm administration) resolved that 3.1 million peasant households would be incorporated into collective farms by the end of 1929-1930 (Davies, *The Socialist Offensive*, pp. 112, 147).

Stalin on the Liquidation of the Kulak – Seventeen Moments ...

As illustrated by the speech excerpted below, Stalin blamed them for food shortages and ordered the collectivization of their farms. In theory only the kulaks were to be targeted, but in practice the government took over the farms belonging to any peasants who opposed collectivization. Angry farmers slaughtered their livestock and wrecked their farm machinery rather than turn them over to the state.

It was a process of ruthless transformation in which the peasant population was coerced into providing the State with grain.

The collectivization that began in 1929 was an extraordinary period of bitter and complex class struggles. It decided what force would run the countryside: the rural bourgeoisie or the proletariat. Collectivization destroyed the economic basis for the last bourgeois class in the Soviet Union, the class that was constantly re-emerging out of small-scale production and the rural free markets.
